Staff changes-over the holidays, we farewelled Mimi Ilyas and Cheryl Kynoch. We thank Cheryl and Mimi for their work over the years, and we welcome Mrs Debbie Livingstone to our office team.

A summary of our Covid-19 safety plan:

- Parents are strongly encouraged to use the RAT tests provided twice weekly on their children. If positive, the child **MUST** stay at home for 7 days.
- If a St Dominic's student lives in a household where someone is positive to Covid they **MUST** stay home.
- Social distancing is in place and is very important.
- If your child is sick, they **MUST** stay at home.
- If your child has any symptoms at school, such as sore throat, headache, sneezing, coughing they will be sent home.
- Hand sanitizer and enhanced cleaning protocols are in place.
- Students in years 3-6 must wear masks at school and Prep-2 students are encouraged to wear masks.
- Masks must be worn inside and on the school grounds by all staff and adults.
- All parents and carers must wait in the car park before and after school.

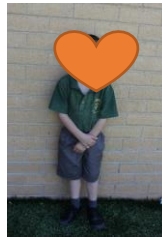
All students should be in their full summer uniform each day except for sports day.
